



## **Title VI Formaldehyde Standards Effective 6-1-18**

New EPA regulation that establishes the world's most stringent emissions standards for composite wood Products (Particle Board, MDF, and Hardwood Plywood) AND products manufactured with these products. IE: Cabinets and Furniture

### **Things You Need to Know**

Purchase Title VI TSCA Compliant Materials

-> Panels made before June 1, 2018, may be sold at any time and used in finished goods

Keep records for 3 years documenting material compliance

Label finished goods with name, date and compliance

-> Fabricators must label every finished good or every box or bundle containing finished goods

EPA will require a third party certification process to certify manufacturers and ensure compliance

NAF and ULEF products are exempt from testing
